In reading Mark Batterson's 40 day prayer challenge, he states this:

You don't need to seek opportunity. All you have to do is seek God. And if you seek God, opportunity will seek you. Don't worry about meeting the right people. If you meet with God, God will make sure you meet the right people at the right time. After all, there is nobody He doesn't know. Its one degree of separation. And if God can change the heart of Pharaoh, He can help you find favor with anybody and everybody. You've got to do God's will God's way. Don't try to manufacture your own miracles. Don't try to answer your own prayers. Don't try to do God's job for Him. Stay humble. Stay patient. Stay focused."


