FROM THE PREACHERS DESK Truth Bomb

A colloquialism in our day and time is the idea that we can be metaphorically hit by a "truth bomb." The phrase "truth bomb" implies the shocking and powerful nature of the truth. When a person is ignorant of the truth, and then exposed to the truth, it has powerful psychological and emotional effects, much like a physical bomb has powerful physical effects.

Have you ever been hit by a truth bomb? I have, and let me tell you, it can really stink! It can also be good. Here are a few from my past, beginning with the stinkers:

- I'm not a great athlete
- I'm not a great singer I'm not overly intelligent
- I'll never be taller

These are just a few of the negative truth bombs that I have experienced. Here's some positives:

I don't have to be a great athlete to have fun

I can sing in a band despite not being a great singer Intelligence is over-rated compared to hard work and ambition My wife loves me even though I'm short

Truth always contains a positive and negative aspect. Paul sums up the positive and negative of the gospel in one sentence:

1 Timothy 1:15 - *It is a trustworthy statement, deserving full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, among whom I am foremost of all.*

Negative truth bomb – I am a sinner.

Positive truth bomb – Jesus came to save me!

Personally, the truth that I am sinner in need of a savior is the greatest "truth bomb" I've ever been hit with – and what a terrible truth – but it was only terrible until I was told how much God loves me. He loved me enough to send Jesus to save me from my sin – what a wonderful truth!
