#### FROM THE PREACHERS DESK

Giving

It is a popular saying that we should give of our three T's: time, talents and treasure. I was told that a few times in my early Christian years with little explanation.

The truth of the matter is that there were many years of my Christian life that I gave very little or not at all. When I say "gave" I am referring to those three T's. The Bible says a little bit about how I spend my time and how I utilize my talents but it says A LOT about how I use my treasure.

Did you know that there are over 2,000 verses in the Bible regarding money? Suffice it to say, it's a big deal. Even though it is an important biblical topic, it is one that has become largely ignored in our church culture today.

It's strange. There are churches today that never talk about money and how we use it and there are churches that never stop talking about money, so much so that new terms have been created such as "The Prosperity Gospel."

I don't want us to ignore the topic of money, or any other biblical topic for that matter! I don't want to talk about money every Sunday either, and I really don't see how it would be possible. What I want to do is discuss the topic when it comes up, just like we discuss every other topic.

Giving has become one of the greatest joys of my life, but like I said earlier, it wasn't always so. What changed? I studied my Bible, asked questions and sought understanding. Afterward, I was more convicted than I have ever been before and I changed. You know, that is exactly what we're supposed to do any time we are convicted about anything! Conviction only comes when we recognize a wrong that must be made right.

What do you know about what the Bible says about giving? Do you know what is expected of you? This week we will learn some of what the Bible says regarding giving. Here is a sneak peek, Matthew 6:2,3,4 (partial)
