We name our children after people that we like. We name them after relatives, sometimes that we knew, sometimes that we didn't know. We give unique names for a variety of reasons, but mainly I think to avoid common or seemingly overused names.

When my wife and I were choosing names for our children, the names of my ex-girlfriends were all off limits.

The names that we chose were Caroline, Julia, Jack and Annie. Why? We like those names. We did not look up the meanings prior to naming. Here they are, just for fun:

Caroline = strong

Julia = youth

Jack = God is gracious

Annie = favored

It is important to note that in other places in the New Testament, a variation of this word is used as an adjective to describe God, but that is not what Jesus is intending here. This is an action verb, loaded with implications.
