FROM THE PREACHERS DESK

No Difference

It's amazing to me how some people do not change. I once got together with one of my best friends from high school, around ten years after we graduated.

We both looked different, but he was not different. He was still at the same maturity level, which was very immature. He still wanted to talk about the same kinds of things and joked about the same things.

He wasn't *trying* to act like he did in high school – He simply was not different.

There are some good qualities that we should maintain our entire life, but there are other qualities that, if they do not change, are evidence that we have not grown, or matured, which is a more appropriate descriptor.

As Christians, our desire should always be to continually grow spiritually, but spiritual growth does not happen accidentally. Paul describes the key to spiritual growth in 2 Corinthians 3:18 –

But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.

As we behold God's glory and as we glorify God with our lives, the power of the Holy Spirit, His good work, transforms us into the image of Christ.

As you grow into the image of Christ, it is impossible to stay the same. I think it's tragic to encounter any person who has not grown or matured in many years. How much more tragic is it to encounter a Christian who has not grown or matured since their conversion!

This week we'll discuss some ways that we can know that our lives are aiming for and headed toward spiritual growth. As we set our hearts on Jesus and living for His glory, God will do wonderful things in your life. Let's grow together!
