FROM THE PREACHERS DESK

Two Religious Things

Do you know what the most irritating verse in the Bible is? It's John 21:25,

And there are also many other things which Jesus did, which if they were written in detail, I suppose that even the world itself would not contain the books that would be written.

It is an irritating verse to me only because I so desperately want to know the other things that Jesus did. Don't you want to know the things that John wanted to share that the Holy Spirit would not permit? Me too.

But we shouldn't get caught up in the things we don't know, but rather, focus on the things that we do know and especially the things that we have been specifically commanded to do.

Most of the teaching that Jesus did was not new teaching. He did corrective teachings when he observed the religious leaders perverting God's original intentions. He explained things that people did not understand from the Old Testament. But did you know that He only introduced two new commands?

The two new commands of Jesus were baptism and the Lord's Supper. All of the Old Testament ceremonial laws were fulfilled entirely when Jesus died on the cross. He now commands only two very simple things from us! Isn't that amazing?

Anyone who puts their faith in Jesus, He commands they be baptized. Anyone who belongs to Jesus, he commands to observe the Lord's Supper. Baptism is a gentle, beautiful picture of dying, being buried and resurrected, just as Jesus brutally died, was buried and was resurrected.

The Lord's Supper is a memorial so that we will never forget Jesus' body that suffered greatly or His blood that was spilled on our behalf. It also serves as time of personal examination to remind us that we are not our own, but that we were bought at an exorbitant price.

Two simple commands, yet there are many who call themselves Christians who not only do not observe these commandments, but teach others that they are completely unnecessary. I pity anyone who would dare stand before Jesus and say that His commands are not important.

If we won't observe these simplest of commands, will we obey Him in anything?
