In fact, just to make it clear to us that there are no exceptions, Jesus says in the same chapter in verses 44 and 45

I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, 45 so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven;

I'm doing this series because God has called us to be a people who are proactive, not reactive. I don't want to fail Jesus in how I respond to the world around me, but I'm not going to do the right things and say the right things accidentally. I need to plan ahead. I need to have my responses ready at a moment's notice.

The ultimate goal of this series is to better equip us to win the world for Christ. He is the only hope in a lost and perishing world. Join me in getting excited about the part we get to play in showing Jesus to the world and living out our destinies as the salt and light of the world.
