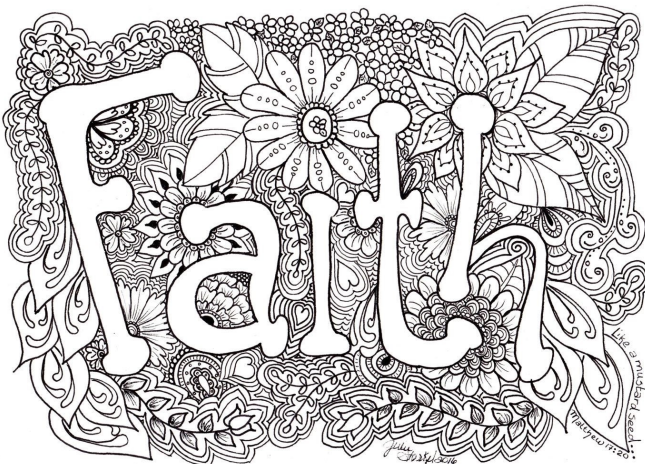

SILVER MAPLE CAMP LADIES RETREAT

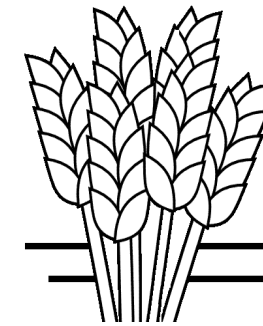
