Imagine if you will, being one of the 12, and Jesus has just explained to you the future of the church is now in your hands. Up to this point, Jesus was in control, but now it’s Acts 1, and Jesus is about to leave for the final time, and in his pre-departure speech, he drops this bombshell of a thought on you. It almost seems unfair, to place such a weighty responsibility into the hands of these guys who have followed Jesus so faithfully. Whether they snarl at it or embrace it, it’s up to them. So let God know he can count on you, by sharing that which has been entrusted into your care.

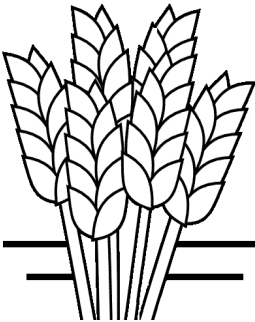
