My Second Favorite Gift

The Lord is a giver of great gifts. Jesus attests to this even. In Mat-thew 7:11, Jesus said,

If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your chil-dren, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give what is good to those who ask Him!

Some gifts are given when we ask, but many others were given be-fore we even existed.

My favorite gift, and I feel that I should say, my favorite gift, of course, is the gift of my salvation. All other gifts are meaningless in comparison.

But salvation isn’t the only gift God gives to His children; Far from it.

My second favorite gift comes in the form of a command from Jesus in Matthew 28:18-20, Jesus said,

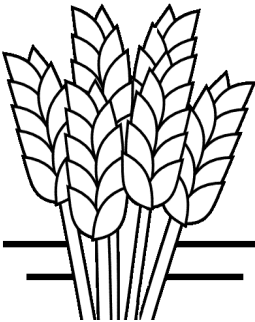
