- After the explosion on the last night, many children (without being asked) stayed until the end to help pick up all the trash and did so with a joyful heart. One child even made the connection that they talked about in the game on Tuesday evening...Serving is fun!
- Several people expressed their excitement over the addition of our Blessing Box outreach project.
- Many adults commented on how convicting the nightly lessons were and what an awesome job the teachers did!
- Many young families commented on how thankful they were to have a meal provided with VBS...This made it much easier for them to come as a family.

BLESSING BOX

You may have noticed something new on our property, close to the west entrance. It's a Children's Ministry service project called a Blessing Box. (Matthew 25) The idea is simple- we collect non-perishable food items and toiletries in hopes of blessing those in our community who are in need of some assistance. We, the church, will provide the majority of the Blessing Box items as donations but the community is welcome to join in and stock the Blessing Box as well. Our children, along with some adult assistance, will be in charge of helping to keep our box stocked up throughout the week. If you feel inclined to participate, you may bring donations anytime. We have labeled tubs set up in the foyer and in the west hallway near the office for you to drop donations. Here is a suggested list of items to contribute:
