He's going back to His home and sending his disciples out to every corner of the globe to talk about what He accomplished and to teach what He taught.

In this way, Jesus will accomplish what He said He would accomplish in Matthew 16:18,

¹⁸...I will build My church...

We do what He said to do in Matthew 28:19-20,

¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spir-

it, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I commanded you...

And He builds His church.

We do the obeying; He does the building. It's not our church, it's His church. If we don't obey Him, He still does the building, but He uses other people as His divine church building tools.

Over two thousand years later, the journey that began with His first disciples, continues with us.


