The church, which is made up of everyone who belongs to Christ, was not intended to exist in isolation. The word translated as church, *ekklesia*, literally means an assembled people.  
  
Paul refers to us collectively as a body and emphasizes how each part of a body is dependent upon the other parts.  
  
We make fellowship a priority because it’s part of God’s plan for our lives. In fellowship we are as God intends for us to be. In fellowship, though very different as individuals, we unite in the commonality of Christ, and though I can’t comprehend all of the supernatural implications of what this means, I do know that it’s a good thing and it’s a powerful thing.
