SINGING IN SPIRIT AND IN TRUTH

People have peculiar ideas about singing in worship. Here is a list of some of them:

- 1. Some feel that singing is just to put one in the mood for worship.
- 2. Some feel that the song worship requires little or no preparation.
- 3. Many feel that singing is not as important a part of the worship as other activities.
- 4. Many feel that only the talented in music should sing, leaving those who know little about music and those whose voices are less pleasing to remain quiet.

The singing part of our worship is often sadly neglected. It demands a reappraisal. Singing in worship has several important objectives:

- 1. It is one way to offer praise to God. "Is any merry? Let him sing praise." (James 5:13).
- 2. It is a time to admonish (Colossians 3:16). The word "admonish" differs from "teach" in that it "reminds and warns."
- 3. When we sing, we teach one another. "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord." (Colossians 3:16).
- 4. Singing enables us to feel God's love in our hearts. "Singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord." (Colossians 3:16). "Singing and making melody in your hearts to the Lord." (Ephesians 5:19).

Did it ever occur to you that your part in singing in the worship might require as much forethought, effort, and study as would any of the Bible classes? The singing of a hymn should be a great experience for us. It can be a prayer, praise, a spiritual song, or an invitation to others.

However many don't take seriously enough the words they sing. We sing, "Sweet Hour of Prayer" and content ourselves with ten or fifteen minutes a day. We sing, "Onward Christian Soldiers" and wait to be drafted in His service. We sing, "Oh, for a Thousand Tongues" and don't even use the one we have. We sing, "There Shall Be Showers of Blessings" and do not come when it rains. We sing, "Blest Be the Tie" and let the slightest offense sever it. We sing, "Serve the Lord with Gladness" and gripe about all we have to do. We sing, "We're Marching to Zion" and fail to march to Bible study and worship. We sing, "Cast Thy Burden on the Lord" and worry ourselves into a nervous breakdown. We sing, "Seeking the Lost" and never invite our next-door neighbor to worship with us.
