FROM THE PREACHERS DESK

Community

Did you know that God has always existed in community? I realize that when we're discussing the Book of Genesis that we are often trying to imagine things that our brains cannot comprehend, but that doesn't mean that we should not think about such things.

I cannot wrap my mind around God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit having always existed, but that has more to do with my understanding of existence and the limitations of my mind than anything else.

Let us look together at a wonderful text that many read over too quickly without absorbing the implications. Genesis 1:26 says,

²⁶ Then God said, "Let <u>Us</u> make man in <u>Our</u> image, according to <u>Our</u> likeness... (emphasis mine)

Who was God speaking to? He was speaking to Jesus and the Holy Spirit, the other two, that, with God, make up the God-head.

Yeah, I can't explain that either, but that doesn't prohibit me from believing it to be true.

But believing it to be true, I'm able to let a great truth sink into my heart and mind. God has always existed in community and He, along with Jesus and the Holy Spirit, created mankind to live in community, with Him, and with other human beings.

What difference does this truth make to us today? It makes a big difference. Since we were created to live in community, we should do so, and as much as is possible, live in community with God.

Adam and Eve lived in community with God before they sinned and then they still had some community with God, but in a very limited way. As wonderful as this is, we still are only able to have a slight taste of the relationship with God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit that is to come.


