FROM THE PREACHERS DESK

New Time, Old Tactics, pt 3

Continuing in our little bulletin series about the danger of false teaching, this article will look at another way in which people are deceived by false teaching.

The manner discussed today is likely the most common way in which anyone believes a falsehood- what I'm referring to is the false beliefs that arise out of not studying the Scriptures personally.

The flip side of this particular coin is two-fold. A three-sided coin, if you will. One side is not studying the Scripture, one side is believing whatever you are taught without investigating to determine if it is true, and the third side is simply believing things based, not on what you have studied, and not what you have been taught, but simply believing based upon your own thoughts and feelings.

I've had many discussions with people about what they believe, but sadly, most people are very poor at articulating why they believe what they believe.

There is much danger in not knowing why we believe what we believe. We observe Eve being questioned by the serpent and ultimately sinning as a result of not knowing what she believes and how to articulate it.

When we don't know what God has said, doubt is easily sown.

There is also much danger in believing whatever you are told without investigating the claims personally. When Satan said to Eve, "Did God really say..." she should have said, wait a minute and I'll call out to Him and ask before I do something I might regret.

The worst and most hopeless case is the person who develops beliefs based on their own thoughts and feelings. Such a person, and we're all guilty of being like this at times, makes themselves out to be a god - all-knowing and incapable of the humility required to be taught, just like Satan.
