## FROM THE PREACHERS DESK

## New Time, Old Tactics pt 2

Last week's article discussed the danger of false teaching that comes from building a theological understanding based upon only one Bible verse without taking into consideration anything else the Bible has to say regarding the same topic.

Another hallmark of false teaching is the decontextualization of the Scripture. I realize that "decontextualization" is probably the largest word I have ever used and that it may sound confusing, but it's not as complicated as it sounds.

It simply means to separate something from its original context. For instance, I once read an article the fact that a well-meaning person wrote about how John the Baptist and Jesus were cousins.

The Bible does indicate that they were related because it says of Mary, Jesus' mother, and Elizabeth, John the Baptist's mother, that they were *syngenis* (Luke 1:36), which does not mean cousin, but simply means "female relative."

It makes sense that Mary and Elizabeth were cousins, or even aunt and niece because they could be either and be from different tribes, which, we know they were.

However, none of these things matter so much as what was said in the article that I read. What the author did was explained the personal experiences she had with her cousins growing up and assumed that Jesus and John had a similar experience.

However, upon reading the Scripture, there is no indication at all that Jesus and John knew each other and as a matter of fact, there's no evidence that they ever even met until Jesus went to John for baptism after John started his ministry.

The example I'm using may be seen as harmless. After all, what does it matter if Jesus and John knew one another? But that's not the point.

The point is that we cannot take our cultural details and insert them into Jewish culture over two thousand years ago as if our cultures were anything alike.

When we study the Scripture, we must, as best we can, understand the culture that existed then and not insert our culture into the lives of those who lived and thought different from us.
