

Christian Community

The longer I live the more and more I see the importance of community. Even in the individualistic society in which we live, saying that community is important is rarely considered controversial. But when I think of community, I mean Christian community, the importance of the community of the family of God.

What’s the big deal about Christian community? Here’s some of the things that my Christian community does for me.

- It reminds me that, though I have no contact with the family that I grew up with, I have the family of God, which is the truest family there is.
- It provides me with the encouragement of fellowship with other people that have the same life goals and aims that I have – to live a life that honors Jesus.
- It empowers me to learn on a deeper level by not relying solely upon my own understanding of God’s Word, but, through discussion, hear differing thoughts and perspectives.

To sum those points up in a few words, through Christian community I’m LOVED, I’m ENCOURAGED, and I LEARN. There are many fringe benefits that branch from these that fills my life with a richness and meaningfulness that I otherwise would not have.

It should also be pointed out that all of this is by God’s great design. One passage that speaks to this is Ephesians 4:16-17, which says:

¹⁵ but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ, ¹⁶ from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.

Let us strive to keep our Christian Community alive and well, for our good and for the glory of God.
