I’ve always heard it said that the only two guarantees in life is death and taxes, but I’ll add another to that list- people predicting the return of Jesus. I’ve been hearing a lot of this talk lately.

Now, just to clarify, there’s nothing wrong with feeling like the Lord’s return may be happening soon. However, if you feel this way, please consider that every generation, from the time of Jesus through today, has felt the same.

Someone will eventually be right, but not because they figured something out that the rest of us haven’t.

You might wonder with so many confident predictions, how can I be so confident that those predictions are wrong and I am right?

I haven’t figured out anything either, however, I feel confident because I believe the words of Jesus from Matthew 24:36, which say-

“But about that day or hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.”

So much more important than understanding the timing of the return of the Lord, is my readiness for His return.

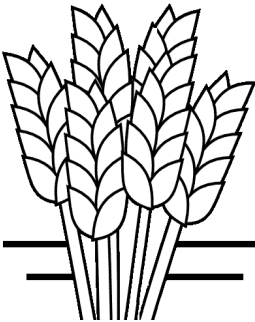
