FROM THE PREACHERS DESK

Back In the Swing of Things

It's such an interesting thought that people are such creatures of habit. People, as a whole, love routine, love tradition and, deliberately or undeliberately, develop habits.

The summertime is a time for many people that causes a break in the ordinary rhythms of life. People travel more in the summer, kids are out of school and in activities, and families that travel, generally do so in the summer.

So it's this time of year that we begin to hear the expression, "I'm ready to get back in the swing of things," meaning that the routines I enjoy have been temporarily unsettled, but now it's time to settle down again.

What makes these behaviors so interesting to me is that one thing we can rely upon in life is change. We rebel against change by attempting to bend the changes and circumstances of life to our wills. Sometimes this works out alright and sometimes it simply doesn't.

Biblically speaking, how am I to think about routines and changes? I don't want to oversimplify the answer, but James 4:14-15 gives us some easy, straightforward, wisdom on the subject:

¹⁴...you do not know what your life will be like tomorrow. You are just a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away. ¹⁵ Instead, you ought to say, "If the Lord wills, we will live and also do this or that."

I think we can all easily see the truth of the statement that we do not know what our life will be like tomorrow. We've all lived long enough to understand that our days may be predictable, but we've also lived enough days to remember the ones that weren't predictable at all. James also inserts the reminder of the brevity of life, which is always a good reminder to help us keep proper perspective.

But then comes the answer. We ought to say, "If the Lord wills, we will live and also do this or that." In other words, it's okay to make plans in life, but not without considering that the Lord is our master and has the right to change our plans. If you know Him and trust Him and love Him, this teaching is far easier to accept.

So I encourage you to seek Him more, get to know Him, learn to trust Him and love Him back. The changes in life will come whether you follow Jesus or not, but they are certainly easier to weather with Him than without Him.
