Have you ever noticed that even the Apostle Peter wrote in 2 Peter 3:15-16, in reference to the teaching of the Apostle Paul, he said.

15...our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given him, wrote to you, 16 as also in all his letters, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand...
