## FROM THE PREACHERS DESK

The Month of Thanksgiving

The older I get, the more I enjoy the holiday of Thanksgiving – and not for the reason you might assume – I have not grown more appreciative of the meal, but rather, of giving thanks.

Being thankful cannot be underestimated. As followers of Jesus, we are called to be thankful. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 says,

<sup>18</sup> in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

We are to be thankful, for one, because we who follow Jesus always have reason to be thankful, however, there are other reasons to be thankful as well.

As we have observed in our study of Romans, that a lack of thankfulness to God is the first reason given why the wrath of God comes against mankind. Romans 1:18 says,

# <sup>18</sup> For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all <u>ungod-</u> liness...

The word translated to ungodliness means, "want of reverence towards God," which includes, but is not limited to, being thankful to God for the many reasons we should be thankful, the chief of which being His demonstrated love for us by sending Jesus to live, die and be resurrected to save us from our sins.

To be thankful is to humble myself before God, recognizing that all good things in my life come from Him and from no other source. When I give credit to myself or other people or anything other than God, I have created an idol and broken the first and greatest of God's commandments.

Let us be a people who never cease to give thanks, and to be sure that our thanksgiving is always to God first and foremost, remembering the words of James 1:16-17 –

 $^{16}$  Do not be deceived, my beloved brethren.  $^{17}$  Every good thing given and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shifting shadow.

# Greek of the Week:

There are two Greek words this week that in English could be synonyms, "known" and "evident" - but at closer glance at the words we see the word "known" is the Greek word *gnōstos*. which means "that which is capable of being known," and we see the word "evident" is the Greek word *phaneros*, which means "plainly recognized and understood."

It's an important distinction because when it comes to God, not all things can be "known," but many things can – those things which God has allowed us to know. The things that God has allowed us to know are "evident," meaning that God has not made the things that He wants us to know about Him difficult to understand.
