Giving In or Resisting?

We live our lives in a constant state of either giving in to the designs of the Lord or resisting the same.

There are many examples of this in the Bible, such as David. We can see David living by faith when he challenges Goliath (1 Samuel 17.) The Lord has taught David to trust in Him by saving him from adversaries he otherwise would have fallen to, such as a lion and a bear (1 Samuel 17:34.)

What a beautiful display of faith when David takes on Goliath and gains victory by the hand of God – a God that he has learned, through experience, to trust. David gives in to the designs of the Lord while everyone else resists.

We also see David resist the Lord's will when he chooses to take another man's wife, resulting in an avalanche of sins (2 Samuel 11.)

David's life is the picture of a man who sometimes does what is right and other times does what is wrong. He sometimes follows the Lord and other times follows his own desires and understanding. Sound familiar?

Our victories and rebellions may not be the same, but all followers of Jesus are continually following Him or straying from the path.

Why bring this up now? I'm compelled to write this now, to ask you and ask myself whether we are giving in to what God wants us to do or resisting His will, because I feel that it has never been more important to both declare our allegiance for Jesus and to give in to His calling.

He's always calling. He's always moving and working in this world. Are we listening? Are we seeking His direction? Are we ready to respond to what He's calling us to?

For our good, and His glory, follow Him.
