FROM THE PREACHERS DESK
The Wrath of God

Our second mini-series within our larger series in the Book of Romans is all about God’s wrath. When people hear that, there’s a lot of different reactions, but I would submit to you that the action that I would desire for us all to have is one of excitement.

Excitement may be the wrong word, or may be too strong of a word, but it’s the emotion that I feel most prevalent as I study, and if I could share that excitement with you, I certainly would.

The subject of the wrath of God is largely ignored by the religious world in general, and I would only be speculating if I guessed why. It shouldn’t be ignored; it’s a major topic in the Bible. The Apostle Paul begins talking about God’s wrath in Romans 1:18 and doesn’t stop until Romans 3:21, just for one instance.

The most important reason why the wrath of God should not be ignored or downplayed is because it is the chief reason why mankind needs good news. Without the presence of bad news, and there is no worse news than the coming of the wrath of God, it is impossible for me to understand how important Jesus coming to be my savior is.

The reason for my excitement in studying the topic this week has come from each time I study, I understand more and more how much God loves me, how much Jesus sacrificed, and what Jesus has saved me from.

The study of God’s wrath has also caused me to understand with better gravity how much God hates sin, which encourages me to fight harder against it as it wars against my desire to glorify God.

I’m not sure that I’ve ever studied another topic that magnifies the greatness of God’s grace, love, patience or devotion to us as the wrath of God.

So, let’s get excited and study God’s wrath!

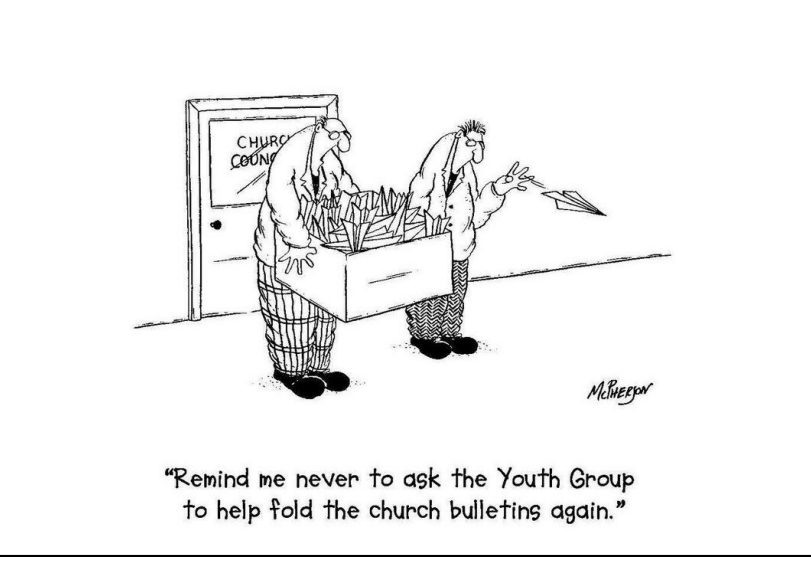
CONGRATULATIONS!

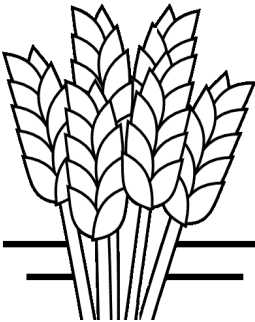
