Fun with 2026

Per my tradition, let’s see what Books of the Bible have 20 chapters and 26 verses and see if there’s one we might want to remember throughout the year. Of course, this is just a fun exercise, not meant to be a serious way to approach anything, biblically speaking.

Exodus 20:26 - ²⁶ *And you shall not go up by steps to My altar, so that your nakedness will not be exposed on it. ’*

Leviticus 20:26 - ²⁶ *Thus you are to be holy to Me, for I the Lord am holy; and I have set you apart from the peoples to be Mine.*

Numbers 20:26 - ²⁶ *and strip Aaron of his garments and put them on his son Eleazar. So Aaron will be gathered to his people, and will die there. ”*

Judges 20:26 - ²⁶ *Then all the sons of Israel and all the people went up and came to Bethel and wept; thus they remained there before the Lord and fasted that day until evening. And they offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the Lord.*

1 Samuel 20:26 - ²⁶ *Nevertheless Saul did not speak anything that day, for he thought, “It is an accident, he is not clean, surely he is not clean.”*

2 Samuel 20:26 - ²⁶ *and Ira the Jairite was also a priest to David.*

1 Kings 20:26 - ²⁶ *At the turn of the year, Ben-hadad mustered the Arame-ans and went up to Aphek to fight against Israel.*

2 Chronicles 20:26 - ²⁶ *Then on the fourth day they assembled in the valley of Beracah, for there they blessed the Lord. Therefore they have named that place “The Valley of Beracah” until today.*

Job 20:26 - ²⁶ *Complete darkness is held in reserve for his treasures, and unfanned fire will devour him; It will consume the survivor in his tent.*

Proverbs 20:26 - ²⁶ *A wise king winnows the wicked, and drives the threshing wheel over them.*

Ezekiel 20:26 - ²⁶ *and I pronounced them unclean because of their gifts, in that they caused all their firstborn to pass through the fire so that I might make them desolate, in order that they might know that I am the Lord. ”*

Matthew 20:26 - ²⁶ *It is not this way among you, but whoever wishes to become great among you shall be your servant,*

Luke 20:26 - ²⁶ *And they were unable to ^[u]catch Him in a saying in the presence of the people; and being amazed at His answer, they became si-lent.*

Greek of the Week

This week in our text is the word “perseverance.” While we under-stand that perseverance means persistence in doing some thing despite some difficulty, the Greek word here carries the same meaning, but with a little extra added to it.

The Greek noun is *hypomonē*, and in addition to the regular meaning of perseverance, in English, this word also carries an implication of cheerfulness.

I like to think of it as the Christian version of perseverance.

Acts 20:26 - ²⁶ *Therefore, I testify to you this day that I am innocent of the blood of all men.*

These verses are interesting, but don’t stand alone very well. That’s be-cause they were never meant to stand alone, but rather, to be studied with-ing the context of the passages in which they were plucked.

While I would never encourage you to study your Bible like this, I would encourage you to study in such a way that you are continually challenged and excited by God’s Word. Happy 2026 to you!


