FROM THE PREACHERS DESK
Pop Quiz

The two most dreaded words from my years as a student were probably the word, "pop" followed by the word, "quiz."

By why? Why did I dread those words? It was for one very simple reason: I was not prepared. I knew that I did not know the answers to the coming questions.

But there was a different type of student in class as well. There weren't many of this other kind, but they were there. These were the students that exclaimed, "Yes!" in full excitement when the teacher announced the quiz was upon us.

Again, why? For the opposite reason of why I was filled with dread – these people knew the answers to the questions that were coming.

As followers of Jesus, we're called to always be ready for pop quizzes. 1 Peter 3:15 says,

15 but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence;

Peter tells us in advance that the quiz is coming someday and when it comes, to be ready *to give and account for the hope that is in you*, which means to explain to others why we follow Jesus.

I don't know of a better place to learn about the details of our salvation than the Book of Romans. It's in Romans that we learn about some great reasons for our hope: Righteousness through faith, justification, redemption, propitiation, etc.

Can you discuss and explain what these things mean? If not, then learn to do so. They are not hard to understand or to explain, and when you understand them and can explain them to others, they are a powerful way to not only explain why you follow Jesus, but within each of these lies the good news of what Jesus does for all who put their faith in Him.

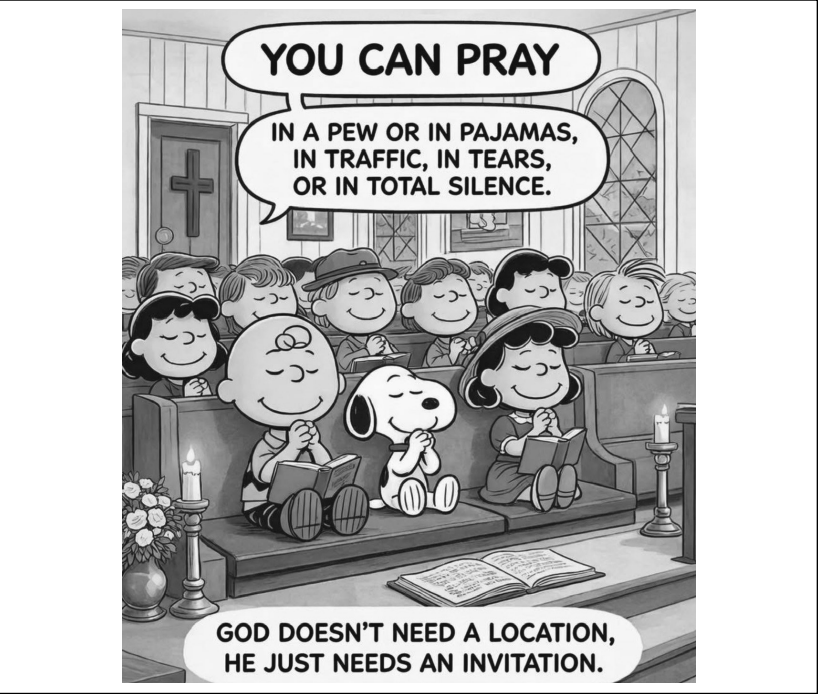

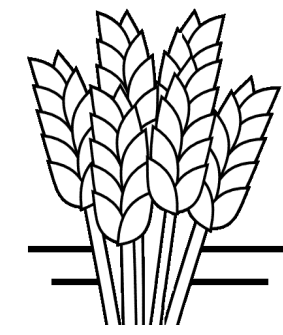
