Hebrew of the Week
 This week we'll look not at a New Testament Greek work, but an Old Testament Hebrew word. The word this week is the Hebrew noun *ma'āsēr*, which translated to English is the word "tithe."
 This word can be found in various places in the Old Testament and this week we will look at its usage in Leviticus 27:30-32. The word literally means, "a tenth part," or what we would call, ten percent.
